This leaflet briefly explains the role of an Educational Psychologist (EP).

EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY SERVICE

Your son/daughter's school has asked the Educational Psychology Service (EPS) to help them to meet your child's needs. You have given your permission for this to happen.

What do Educational Psychologists do?

Educational Psychologists work in schools, with other educational settings and with other professionals, to support children.

Their aim is to help schools and parents/carers to find a way of improving things when a child's learning is significantly affected.

Usually the Educational Psychologist (EP) will start the process by talking to relevant school staff. They will always want to gain your views and ideas too, possibly at the initial meeting or at a later review.

The Educational Psychologist (EP) may do some or all of the following:

- Observe your child in class.
- Spend time talking to and perhaps carrying out tasks with your child.
- Talk to people involved; you, school staff, and other professionals.
- Work together with others to make a plan to help your child.

What will happen next?

The Educational Psychologist (EP) may do some or all of the following:

- Provide verbal feedback to you and school staff about their involvement.
- Write a report and copy it to you, the school, and with your permission, to relevant professionals .
- With your permission, refer your child to another professional.

The school will make sure that the ideas that are agreed are included in your child's Individual Education Plan.

Beth mae Seicolegwyr Addysgol yn ei wneud?

Eu nod yw helpu ysgolion a rhieni/gofalwyr i ganfod ffyrdd o wella pethau pan effeithir yn sylweddol ar ddysg plentyn.

Fell arfer bydd y Seicolegydd Addysgol yn dechrau'r broses drwy siarad gyda staff ysgol perthnasol. Byddant bob amser eisiau clywed eich barn a'ch syniadau chi hefyd, efallai yn y cyfarfod dechreuol neu mewn adolygiad diweddarach.

Gall y Seicolegydd Addysgol wneud rhai neu'r cyfan o'r dilynol:

- Arsylwi eich plentyn yn y dosbarth.
- Treulio amser yn siarad gyda'ch plentyn ac efallai'n gwneud tasgau gydag ef/hi
- Siarad gyda'r bobl sy'n gysylltiedig: chi, staff yr Ysgol a gweithwyr proffesiynol eraill.
- Cydweithio gydag eraill i wneud cynllun i helpu eich plentyn.

Beth fydd yn digwydd nesaf?

Gall y Seicolegydd Addysgol wneud rhai neu'r cyfan o'r dilynol:

- Rhoi adborth llafar i chi a staff yr Ysgol am eu hymgyfraniad
- Ysgrifennu adroddiad ac anfon copi atoch, yr Ysgol, a gyda'ch caniatâd, i weithwyr proffesiynol perthnasol
- Gyda'ch caniatâd, cyfeirio eich plentyn at weithiwr proffesiynol arall.

Bydd yr ysgol yn gwneud yn sicr fod y syniadau y cytunwyd arnynt yen cael eu cynnwys yng Nghynllun Addysg Unigol eich plentyn.
