School Uniform



At Castle Park Primary School, we are proud of our children in their school uniform as we feel it promotes a sense of belonging. We believe it is practical and smart and identifies everyone with our school.

Our school colours are red, white and grey. Our school uniform policy strongly encourages that all children wear school uniform when attending school and when participating in a school organised event. All items of clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name on it to prevent items being lost.

Uniform: Grey trousers, grey skirt, grey pinafore, white shirt/ white polo shirt, red cardigan/red sweatshirt and plain black (appropriate) footwear.

Summer Uniform: Pupils may wear red and white checked dresses or grey formal shorts.

Jogging bottoms and trainers are discouraged to be worn, except during P .E. sessions.

No pupil is allowed to wear jewellery other than plain ear studs.

P.E. Kit: Black jogging bottoms/black shorts, t-shirt and trainers/daps. *During P.E. sessions ear studs are to be taped and watches removed for health and safety reasons.*
