What's been happening?

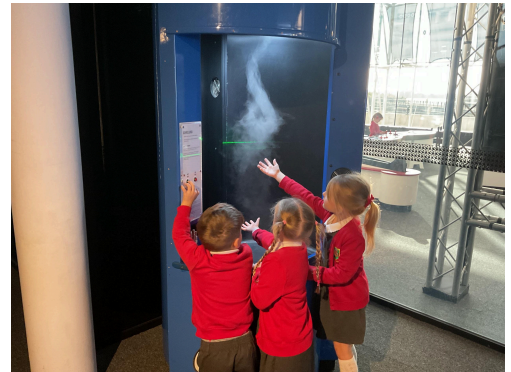
